Running Time: 70 minutes

Audience Lock Out: Dependant on seating layout

Audience Warnings:

- Partial Nudity
- Adult Themes
- Strobe Effects

Pre Show Announcement: An announcement must be made pre show instructing the audience to refrain from the use of flash photography etc.

Dressing Rooms

A minimum of 1 dressing room is required. 2 dressing rooms preferred.

Mirrors, makeup lights, hanging space, kettle and access to running water in or near dressing rooms is required.

Free internet access and kitchen is appreciated.

Dressing rooms must be private, secure and close to the stage.

Laundry facilities in venue is preferred, with access to washing machine and hand washing facilities, as well as space and hangers to dry (most costumes cannot go into a drying machine) and steamer.

Back stage

Hanging space (costume rack) and one prop tables required side of stage for fast changes. If possible one prop table and hanging space either side of stage is appreciated.

Stage

Rouge has been developed for spiegel tent style performance, and has been adapted to work with a proscenium arch or front on stage.

Cabaret format/ in the semi round:

Central stage: Minimum 5m x 5m square or 5m circle

Catwalk or back section of stage: 2m x 2m or similar

Min. stage height: 5.5m

Min wing space: Wings not required

Stage (proscenium arch setup):

Min. stage width: 5m

Min. stage depth: 6m

Min. stage height: 5.5m

Min wing space: Wings not required

Preferred stage width: 7m

Preferred stage depth: 7m

Preferred stage height (to proscenium): 7m

Preferred wing space: Wings not required

The stage must be a flat and level timber stage appropriate for circus acts involving balance

A minimum weight rating of 150kgs per square meter is required.

A raked stage will compromise the quality of the show and may result in some acts being modified or cut from the performance.

Sound

Pre-recorded music played from computer
Headset microphone
2 x foldback wedges (depending on stage layout)

Lights

NOTE: This list is still under scrutiny and is subject to change

We have a professional lighting design that can be appropriated into any venue.

Technical rating: Medium
Minimum bump in time: 5 hours
Bump out time: 1 hour

Ideal lighting for basic design consists of the following.
Can be appropriated at an additional cost to the presenter.

Minimum Console requirement:
LSC Clarity VX20 with Pc and additional screen.
If no operator is found we can supply one for the tour or change the desk at further cost.

Equipment:
6x martin mac 700 or equivalent
5x martin mac 550 or equivalent
12x martin Rush MH6
9x Led parcans RGBW
9x Etc Source 4 25-50 zoom
6x par 16 or par 20 birdies
6x LED strip pan bars (Fusion bar or equivalent)
1x water based hazer
1x Dmx splitter (dd8 or equivalent)
5x Set piece LED poles, (if set cannot be toured then sunset strips or LED RGBW strips may be required)

Rigging

NOTE: The show CAN be performed without aerials, without effecting show runtime

There is 1 aerial acts and 2 high risk ground to air acts.

There is an aerial hoop act. It will be paged or struck when it is not being used.

The performers who are trained aerialists carry out all the mid show rigging. There is an Australian Standard qualified rigger as part of the touring party. **The performers reserve the right to deem the rigging unsafe in any venue and remove the acts from the show as a result.**

Risk assessment document is available on request.

Venue Requirements for Aerial Act:

- Grid Access upon arrival for bump in.
- At least 1 points in the grid with a minimum load rating of 1 tonne.
- Copy of venue plan at least 1 month prior to tour start date.

Luggage & Freight

All props, costumes and set are able to be transported on flights with additional luggage purchased. In total there is 11 cases that need to be flown, as well as personal luggage. For domestic flights within Australia our cast and crew are members of organisations that offer additional checked luggage for no additional charge on Virgin Australia and Qantas.

Luggage

- 3 x suitcases (costumes, props)
- 1 piece circular 1m diameter x 30cm (hoops, aerial hoop)
- 3 pieces 90cm x 50cm x 50cm (chairs)
- 1 piece circular 90cm diameter x 20cm (handstand base & canes)
- 1 drum case (light poles)
- 1 suitcase (light bases, control box & cabling)
- 1.8m x 30cm x 30cm (roue cyr)

Transport

Domestic Flights

For flights within Australia we prefer to be flown with either Virgin Australia or Qantas due to luggage allowances wherever possible.

International Flights

For international flights we have no preference for airline, however airlines that offer additional luggage at no or low cost would be preferred to avoid having to freight the gear. Where there is a stopover in an airport for longer than 4 hours we request a lounge pass per person where there is an appropriate pay-to-enter lounge in the airport.

Overland

For travel overland we prefer one large van and one people mover. Alternatively three large passenger vehicles such as SUV or large station wagon.

To/from Venue

A large vehicle (8 seater van) plus trailer, or multiple vehicles are required for transporting touring company and equipment to and from the venue. This vehicle must accommodate 7 touring party members and 18 cases plus drivers.

Ideally the accommodation provided should be walking distance (no more than 10 minutes) from the venue (or easily accessible via public transport). Should this not be possible, the Presenter is to provide adequate ground transport (such as hire cars or taxi vouchers) for use by company.

Accommodation

For stays where the Presenter is to supply accommodation, the Presenter is to provide six rooms in minimum four-star accommodation. This is an Australian Union Requirement. Touring party is happy to stay in shared apartments or houses with multiple bedrooms, so long as the bedrooms are separate to the shared spaces. Accommodation with cooking facilities is ideal in all circumstances and required for seasons of over 3 nights.
